



Rules and Etiquette for StarSkate & Senior Skaters
To be signed & returned to MBSC prior to the first night of skating

RULES & ETIQUETTE:

GOOD CONDUCT ON AND OFF THE ICE ARE A MUST. IF THIS RULE IS NOT FOLLOWED, THE STUDENT MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PROGRAM WITHOUT A REFUND.

- If for any reason, you are getting off the ice, let your coach know.
- Do not loiter on the ice after a fall, keep moving!
- Jeans are not appropriate attire.
- Bobbie-pins and loose hairpins are not allowed as they create serious hazards if they fall on the ice.
- Food and drinks are not allowed on the ice. This includes chewing gum!
- Skaters and their parents should not interfere with a coach and/or student during a lesson.
- When a skater's solo music is being played, move aside for that skater so that they may proceed.
- Music will be played for coaches first and all others in the order they are requested.
- Foul language is not acceptable on the ice or in the dressing rooms and you will be asked to leave the ice after one warning.
- Conflicts between skaters should be brought to the attention of the Coaches and/or executive members **in writing** for resolution.
- Coaches and the music person have the authority to ask skaters to leave the ice.
- Test permission forms **must** be completely filled in and payment made **by the deadline** or the test **will not** be taken.
- There will be a social fee added to the cost of the tests in the amount of \$5.00.
- A permission form will be required from your home club test chairperson before you will be allowed to try a test at another club.
- The 2017/2018 competition schedule will be posted on the bulletin board. Please check it for upcoming competitions. Scheduling of competitions is between the coach and student.

This form must be signed by both skater and parent and must be returned to the club prior to the first night of skating or the skater will not be allowed on the ice.
